#### 70th Anniversary of EFCJ

In September, the Evangelical Free Church (EFC) of Japan celebrated its 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary. There were 750 participants and they wrote us messages (see the photo on the right)! We were really encouraged.

In 1947, the first EFC missionary from the USA came to Japan. He started his ministry with a small English conversation class, and there are now 65 EFC churches all over Japan (but in the center of Tokyo).

Although we have not even started the regular service,

this conference reminded us of God's faithfulness and gave us confidence in what He will do through this ministry.
