Our original plan was to start inviting non-Christians to our worship services since April; however, under the COVID19 influence, we had no choice but to change our plan. We believe the Lord is the one who will carry forward the plan that He has prepared, regardless of unpredictable circumstances. We would like to report the current situation while praying for the complete end of COVID19 chaos as soon as possible.

TCC had started broadcasting our worship service online from the beginning of March (prior to the "Stay Home"

request) because there was a sister who was unable to attend the worship service because of her family's health concern. That made it easy for us to respond to the government's request in April. We believe it was God's divine preparation for us. In addition, because we have informed many acquaintances and friends that we are starting the church (official Sunday services) in April, we have simply changed the announcement to "Because we cannot gather together, we are starting Online service for now!" We were able to spread the word more than we expected so it was also a blessing.

As the situation worsened, the pianist hasn't been able to attend the service anymore. But instead, a new player was provided by God around the same time. About half a year ago, we met a music missionary from the US, Ellie, who has just completed her deputation in the United States and returned to Tokyo in April. After she stayed home for 14 days, she joined us at the Easter service. She lives within walking distance and was grateful to be able to celebrate Easter together by saying, "I've attended the first real worship in a month!"

We haven't been able to worship with the three core members given by the Lord for a while, but we talk and pray

with each other online every week. Please pray for Emi, who works in the medical field as a nurse, will be especially protected from the risk of infection.

Hatae is in awe how God leads and guides all the encounters with families through the program.
