On New Year's Eve, a baptismal service was held for a Chinese sister, Wang Ting. She came to Japan last summer with her only daughter from Vietnam for a new job. An American missionary working for a church in Hanoi, where she had been seeking for 5 years, saw our website and introduced TCC to her. Thankfully, she made a confession of faith at the "Monja Party" held after three years interval due to COVID-19. She said, "It was the best meal I've had in Japan." How hard and painful life in Japan had been. But in the midst of all that, the Lord touched her, and we worshiped His name.

Pray for the city

We had a one-hour prayer walk. We prayed freely as we were shown things, people, and events that caught our eye. We are looking for a rental property and felt that the advice was right, saying that we should look at the whole town, not just the property. We will keep on doing this activity in 2024.

On the other hands, Tsukiji was a settlement where foreign missionaries were allowed to live 150 years ago, and the "Society to study about Settlements" researches its history and regularly publishes its findings. Through the introduction of the landlady of their home in Tsukishima, Pastor and his wife began to participate in the group. People who have been active in the Ginza area for a long time also participate. We hope we will have a good encounter with them. The venue is Tsukiji Catholic Church, with St. Luke's Tower in the background. Missionaries also loved this town and established schools and hospitals in the hope of saving the Japanese people. We are now in the midst of this history. We would be grateful if you could have a chance to visit us and join us to pray for our town.

Sister Natsumi Shoyama has been serving TCC as a trainee since last year. She was saved through missionaries at a church in Gifu, then led to a Japanese church in Sydney, but had to return home due



to the COVID-19 in July 2020. When she returned to Japan, she was advised to gather in a church where you feel the need to build up the church, because when the church looks respectable, you may think as if your faith were respectable. Finally, she returned to Japan and was led to TCC, which we were just after the establishment only with a few people. She is now being used greatly as a worker to build up the church.
